Accessible Participation

I have asked and accounted for everyone's individual accessibility requirements.	
I have provided all relevant background information at least 48 hours in advance.	
I have identified an accessible location for engagement, including a safe/quiet space.	
All documents & videos are in good practice accessible formats, in youth-friendly language.	

Inclusive Participation

	encouraged attendees to introduce elves by sharing their preferred names, red pronouns and a visual description.
